By taking part in LEAP, you will learn:

- How to use your knowledge and research skills in a real-life project
- Transferable skills linked to consultancy (e.g., project management, negotiation, communication, evaluation)
- How to work with a client to solve problems for a real-life project
- How to reflect on achievements and learn from your experiences

What we offer:

This is a paid opportunity. Trainees must participate in:

- Three two-hour training sessions focusing on evaluation and consultancy skills (4, 11, 18 May 2022)
- Approximately three days' work researching and creating an evaluation output (May/June 2022)
- A 90-minute sharing and reflection session to consolidate your skills and share what you've learned. (29 June 2022)

A fee of £750 will be paid to trainees through TalentBank. This is based on a £25 hourly rate and a total of four days' training and work.
